In terms of other soaring software, I did buy the original version of the Condor Simulator. I didn't get on with it very well, but part of the problem was that I did not have a full set of yoke and rudder pedal controls, which made it quite hard to fly. I also couldn't get on with the lack of depth cues, so I have pretty much abandoned it and never tried Version 2.

That said, the series of articles in Soaring magazine on how to use it for training is very intriguing, and the author has done a tremendous amount of work setting up a syllabus and lesson plans. If you have good joystick and rudder pedal attachments for your PC, and especially if you have multiple screens, it might well be worth a try. If they ever make a virtual reality version of the software, it might be spectacular.
